OVERVIEW

He specializes in cases involving sexual misconduct (Title IX), freedom of speech, due process, and religious liberty.

Derek represents higher education institutions of all types, from major research universities to private religious colleges. He represents clients at all stages of litigation, including presettlement negotiations, dispositive motion practice, trials, arbitrations and appeals.

Derek's clients face lawsuits from students, faculty, employees and contractors, as well as regulatory enforcement actions from the U.S. Department of Education and equivalent state agencies. Related to his litigation practice, Derek assists colleges and universities in minimizing litigation risk by ensuring compliance with requirements of federal and state regulations, with a special emphasis on Title IX (sexual misconduct) and the Clery Act (campus crime reporting). He is often called on to conduct sensitive investigations involving allegations of misconduct against prominent employees, student-athletes, and athletic teams.

 college's religious beliefs. Obtained dismissal in the college's favor and successfully defended
 the judgment on appeal to the U.S. Court of Appeals, Sixth Circuit, which concluded the college
 was exempt from the faculty member's religious discrimination claim due to the college's status
 as a religious institution.
- Defended former superintendent and principal of school district in case involving seven-figure negligence claims brought by injured student. Obtained summary judgment in favor of clients in groundbreaking application of Paul D. Coverdell Teacher Liability Protection Act and successfully defended case on appeal to state supreme court.
