OVERVIEW

Tamia assists both attorneys and families through the firm's pro bono practice.

As the firm's family court paralegal facilitating pro bono cases for attorneys and clients, Tamia reviews motions, briefs, reports and other legal documents; assists with case strategies; and facilitates depositions. She also manages conflict checks for all pro bono matters in the firm's Kansas City office.
