Targeted Discovery Results in Exceptional Outcome for Direct-Mail Client

A direct-mail client sued a vendor for millions of dollars when the vendor lost or delivered late more than 100 million pieces of mail for dozens of the client's customers. The vendor countersued for millions of dollars in unpaid invoices and breach of warranty. Megan relied on cutting-edge discovery efforts to untangle a complex web of transactional history and to establish that almost the entirety of the unpaid invoices claim was based on mail that was lost or delivered late.

The result was a multimillion-dollar settlement in the client's favor. In addition, Megan's strategic use of third-party discovery to the vendor's customers resulted in the vendor's voluntary dismissal of the multimillion-dollar breach of warranty claim. Megan's perseverance and calculated approach to discovery unveiled the irrefutable facts that led to the exceptional result for the client.
